- Though many volunteers have a background with the fire service, it is not required to contribute one's skills to the museum
- The Greater Hanover Area Fire Museum does not discriminate towards any individuals (staff and visitors included)

- Individuals with skills in cleaning, conversation, teaching, organization and documentation are just some of the ways a person can be a part of the organization
- Volunteers can be of any age, but minors under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a guardian
- Those interested in giving tours to school groups with minors must complete a background check at no cost to them

- Museum hours are Wednesdays 9AM to 3PM, and the first and third Saturday of each month 9AM to 3PM. There may be occasional special events outside of these hours. Volunteers may work outside regular hours in certain circumstances.
